

COURSE NAME: Master of Planning

Eligibility: A pass in recognized Bachelor's Degree in Architecture, Planning, Civil Engineering or Master's Degree in Economics, Geography, Sociology, Anthropology, Environmental Science, Statistics, Social works with specialisation in Community Development and Rural Development.

Obtained at least 50% (45% in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) in the qualifying degree examination.

Entrance Test: Candidate has to appear OJEE-2015 PGAT entrance test of 1 hour duration, 60 Multiple Choice Questions.

10 questions will be of Logical Reasoning type, 10 questions will be Arithmetic reasoning and 40 questions will be of basic Architectural concept related.
