

JOINT ENTRANCE EXAMINATION-2015, ODISHA GUIDELINE FOR BAMS/BHMS COUNSELLING AND ADMISSION

- **ON-LINE REGISTRATION: 05-11-2015 TO 08-11-2015**
- **CENTRAL COUNSELLING AND ADMISSION AT OJEE CELL, GANDAMUNDA, BHUBANESWAR FROM 13-11-2015 TO 15-11-2015. Rank wise schedule will be notified later.**
- **BAMS admission Registration is open. OJEE BAMS/BHMS Rank holders are eligible for registration.**
- **Candidates who have taken admission in BHMS course and satisfied with their admission need not come for counselling.**
- **OJEE BHMS/BAMS rank holders who have registered for BHMS, will be considered for Central Counselling of BAMS/BHMS.**
- **OJEE BHMS/BAMS rank holders who have not registered for BHMS, are allowed to register on stipulated date for consideration of Central Counselling for BAMS/BHMS.**

All candidates who have registered for BHMS are eligible to participate in both BHMS and BAMS counselling. They need not register again. Newly registered candidates will also be eligible for BAMS and BHMS counselling. All registered candidates will be eligible for vacant BHMS seats, if any vacancy will arise during central counselling.

ELIGIBILITY

1. The candidates must be of **17 years** of age as on **31.12.2015**.
2. The parents of candidates must be permanent native of Odisha. Every candidate has to produce **Resident / Nativity certificate (Form No.-III, See Rule-3 of Govt. of Odisha)** during certificate verification.
3. The candidate must have passed +2 Sc. and in the subjects of **Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English** individually and must have secured minimum of 50% marks taken together in **Physics, Chemistry & Biology** at +2 Sc. level for General Candidate (GE). This minimum mark is 40% for SC/ST candidates.

DRAFTS AND CERTIFICATES REQUIREMENT DURING CENTRAL COUNSELLING

1. All candidates who will take part in central counselling of BHMS/BAMS have to deposit a nonrefundable demand draft of Rs. 450/- towards counseling fee In favour of “OJEE - 2015” drawn on any Scheduled Bank payable at Bhubaneswar.
2. Another draft of Rs 5000/- for university registration fee, In favour of “OJEE - 2015” drawn on any Scheduled Bank payable at Bhubaneswar to be deposited during central counselling. **Candidates who have deposited Rs. 5000/- during BHMS counselling and admission need not deposit again.**
3. The **relevant documents** of the candidate will be verified.

Originals will be verified and one set of self-attested photocopy has to be submitted.

Nativity / Resident certificate is required for all candidates seeking admission to the course.
- vii. SC/ST Certificate by birth issued by competent authority, Government of Odisha
- viii. Green Card issued by Family Welfare Dept. Govt. of Odisha
- ix. Ex Service man Certificate issued by Rajya Sainik Board, Bhubaneswar

- PC board report from SCB Medical College, Cuttack is with the JEE Office. So candidates who are qualified are to come to JEE cell for provisional allotment/admission on declared date and time.
- After central counselling at OJEE cell during 28-10-2015 to 30-10-2015 all seats are filled up in BHMS course.
- So present position is zero vacancy in BHMS.
- But during central counselling for BAMS, if any seat is released due to resignation of a BHMS candidate from his/her previously admitted seat to take admission in BAMS, vacancy arising thereby will be displayed.
- Merit wise any registered rank holder can take admission from that point of time.
- **If a candidate want to resign from BHMS admitted seat and want to take admission in BAMS seat has to report at counselling center on *scheduled date and time strictly based on general rank.* Failing which that candidate cannot participate in counselling process.**

** Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India has been moved by the Department for granting permission in favour of KATSAC, Berhampur and it is expected the permission will be granted before counselling.

GUIDELINES FOR CENTRAL COUNSELLING AND PROVISIONAL ADMISSION:

1. Admission will be done strictly as per merit.
2. Only one person (guardian) will be allowed with the candidate to the waiting hall for counselling.
3. Candidates have to put their signature in an attendance sheet at the sitting hall.
4. Candidates coming after the schedule time will be allotted a seat/college from the balance seats available at that point of time taking merit into consideration. (This is not applicable for BHMS admitted candidates. BHMS admitted candidate has to report at counselling center on *scheduled date and time strictly based on general rank*. Failing which that candidate cannot participate in counselling process.)
5. Provisional allotment/ admission will be done at the venue of central counselling. The candidate must bring all the original certificates including original CLC/SLC from the institution last attended and one set of photocopy of all relevant documents has to deposit for admission, failing which no admission will be made and candidature will be rejected.
6. Candidate has to deposit required fees at the counselling spot positively, failing which no allotment will be made and candidature will be rejected.
7. Undertaking of any kind shall not be allowed.
